**WELCOME TO PEACE RIVER DOG FANCIERS, INC.'S (PRDF) TRAINING CLASSES. IN ORDER TO MAKE OUR CLASSES A POSITIVE EXPERIENCE FOR EVERYONE INVOLVED WE ASK THAT YOU FOLLOW THE FEW RULES OF THE TRAINING CLASSES.**

All dogs must be supervised and under control at all times. Do not leave your dog unattended indoors or out. Do not tie your dog to trees, tables, chairs etc.

All dogs must be on a leash. Leashes may be no longer than 6ft. unless otherwise directed by a training instructor. NO "FLEXI-LEADS" please.

Dogs are not allowed in the lobby after sign-up night. Please use side entrance to the gym.

Please do not allow your dog to approach another dog unless you have gotten permission from that dog's owner. Not all dogs are initially friendly.

Please do not allow your dog to "urine mark" walls, chairs, tables, etc. inside or outside the building. If this happens, or if your dog has an accident on the floor inside the building, please notify a club member so the area can be properly cleaned.

Bags will be provided for the purpose of picking up after your dog. Please dispose of all dog waste in the container provided at the side door.

Do not dispose of cigarettes on the grounds; please put them in the container of sand provided at the side door.

All dogs must have proof of current vaccinations: Rabies, Distemper, Parvovirus, and Bordetella.

Please do not bring your dog to class if it is sick, has fleas or is in heat.

No abuse of any dog will be tolerated. This includes hitting, yelling, choking, etc. We believe in training by positive reinforcement and rewarding good behavior, as opposed to punishing bad behavior.

No refunds are available from Peace River Dog Fanciers, Inc. A refund request must be made by you to Charlotte County no later than the end of the first night of class.

Children are always welcome to come and observe classes, but we ask that they remain seated quietly under the supervision of an adult at all times. Junior handlers (children) are encouraged to train their dogs. However, they must be old enough, big enough, and strong enough to handle and control their dogs. They also need to be supervised by an adult at all times.

Dress comfortably and appropriately - Jeans, shorts, T-shirts, tennis shoes, etc. NO sandals, flip-flops, open toed shoes, high heels, skirts, dresses, etc. are permitted in the rings.

Please be considerate of others taking or teaching classes and keep conversations and other distractions to a minimum.

***You can help us maintain the privilege of using this building by following these rules. Failure to do so will result in a warning on the first offense and will be grounds for dismissal without a refund thereafter.***
